02. **APPLICATION**

PREP WORK



The Scholarship Application works best in Chrome on a desktop, laptop or Chromebook.

1. Review the list of [2024 Scholarships](#) ([click link](#))
2. Select which ones you will apply for
3. Pull together needed documentation
 - a. FAFSA Student Aid Index (SAI) number
 - b. Current High School transcript
4. Prepare your essay responses (see next slide)
5. Plan who will provide recommendation(s)

NOTE: Ask for recommendations early, to allow time for the person(s) to complete the recommendation form before the March 25, 2024 deadline.

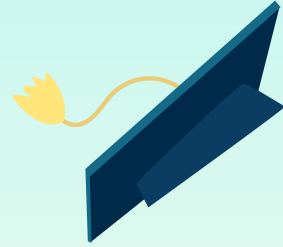
ESSAYS

Three required essays (everyone must do these)

1. Explain your future educational and career plans and why you chose them (250 words)
2. Explain how you plan to pay for your post high school education (250 words)
3. Explain how you have served your school and community to include community service, STUGO, clubs, sports, work, leadership, etc. (300 words)

Up to four additional essays, for specific scholarships

- Merica Family Life Challenges
- PTO Falcon Legacy
- Rotary Club of Fountain Hills Service Above Self
- Jean Marie Boatman Memorial/Daughters of the American Revolution



APPLICATION STEPS

Enter your personal info
(name, address, etc.)

Enter info about the school you plan to attend and your FAFSA Student Aid Index (SAI) number

Select the scholarships you are applying for

Essays: 3 everyone must complete, plus up to 4 additional essays depending on selected scholarships.

Attach your high school transcript

[Recommendation Forms](#) (click link) from a school or community member who knows you are required for some scholarships.

You can request recommendations at any time during the application process.



PRO TIPS


Before entering the [Scholarship Application](#), (click link) have ready your:

- FAFSA Student Aid Index (SAI) Number
- Essay responses
- Current High School grade transcript
- Name and email addresses of individuals providing your, [Recommendation Form\(s\)](#) (click link)
 - Ask their permission first!
 - Tell them what types of scholarships you are applying for and why their recommendation is needed.
 - Do not wait until the deadline to ask for recommendations, or the person will not have time to complete them for you.

NOTE: The Application cannot be saved. It must be completed in one session
